DESKTOP ACCESS:

- ✓ **WebCat** – RSIC’s online catalog/gateway, with browsing and word-phrase searching, user remote requests, and personal user files
- ✓ **Online Databases and Systems** – Numerous indexing/abstracting tools for various subjects and types of publications
- ✓ **E-Journals** – References to articles, sometimes with full text, in electronic format, from diverse publishers and vendors
- ✓ **Selected Internet Links** – Numerous connections to Web sites relevant to the Redstone community
- ✓ **AMCOM and MSFC Reports** – Selected items with electronic full text

IN-HOUSE ACCESS

- ✓ **Books** – 250K volumes covering all technical and scientific subject areas; encyclopedias, dictionaries, and other reference sources.
- ✓ **Journals** – Over 1400 subscriptions to journals in hard copy covering many scientific areas. 111K bound volumes.
- ✓ **Documents** – 2.27 million documents in hard copy and microfiche and electron.

HOW TO BECOME A RSIC REGISTERED USER

- If you are a government DOD or MFSC employee assigned to the Arsenal or Huntsville, you may register online at our website: <https://rsic.redstone.army.mil> or come by the library and register in person.
- Contractors with a current DOD or MSFC contract, may print form from <https://rsic.redstone.army.mil> or come by the library for registration form and instructions for its completion or you can receive them via email.
- In both cases, once U.S. citizens become a registered user, you will be issued a user id and PIN which will allow you to access to our online services.
